

IN REMEMBRANCE OF JOHN FRU NDI : ARGUABLY THE GREATEST POST REUNIFICATION CAMEROONIAN POLITICIAN

One year ago today, the chieftain of the Social Democratic Front or SDF, John Fru Ndi, left this world. His demise was a great tragedy to Cameroon at a moment that the country is at crossroads. For John Fru Ndi was arguably the greatest post reunification politician and the only man under whose stewardship the Social Democratic Front did not only become the largest intra and extra parliamentary

opposition, it is the only political party that was able to beat the ruling CPDM and also match their nationwide presence.

Since the SDF challenged the ultra dominant position of the ruling in 1992 and 1997, no other political party has been able to remotely attained the hegemony and aura of the SDF.

The key to the success of the SDF was a mixture of populist rhetoric and

a clear cut political ideology and message. The other layer of its success was John Fru Ndi, himself. He was an astute politician and articulate,courageous and charismatic. Cameroonian identified themselves in him. He led by example by always taking the lead during protests marches against the government. John Fru Ndi still holds the record as the only post reunification political leader who has circumnavigated the country 22 times.

His nationalistic credentials suffers no doubt and he believed in peaceful protest and refused violence.

Savior of the nation

When the so-called Anglophone crisis began in 2016, the cause of which according Prof Victor Julius Ngoh ,in his book: Former Southern Cameroon's: the third option and the Anglophone problem.1959-2020,

A historico-conflict study : it is the refusal of the Ahmado Ahidjo and Paul Biya to address the root causes of the conflict is the reason why we are where we are today.

While everyone thought John Fru Ndi and his party will back calls made by a section of people in the North west and South West and their diaspora population for the partition of Cameroon, John Fru Ndi supported national unity. His actions was reminiscent to a similar act played by another great pan-Cameroonian politician, John Ngu Foncha.

John Fru Ndi's unflinching and un-nuanced backing of national unity, when he had all the reasons to have a contrary position, saved Cameroon from disintegration. He instead called on Ambazonians, the arrowheads of the uprising to follow peaceful democratic principles which is the only trajectory to correct the historic injustices that they are facing in Cameroon.

And for courageously standing up against disunity, he was kidnapped and tortured by some zealous Ambazonians. In line with his inclusive and openness, he took part at the Major National Dialogue because he sincerely believed it could be the start of initiatives to address the perineal anglophone crisis.

Politics is not war

John Fru Ndi also led a rapprochement between his party and the ruling CPDM climaxed by the famous handshake between him and President Paul Biya in Bamenda. Most people criticized him for that, but he demonstrated that politics is just a game of ideas and not meant to create enmities. He has laid a national template for political tolerance, political courage and patriotism.

Regrets

John Fru Ndi was an extremely humble man even though sometimes tempestuous. In a

touch of humility seldom manifested by politicians of his calibre, he once told me that, I have made several mistakes, but that which trumps all of them was my decision to boycott the 1992 legislative elections. If we had participated, we would have won and made Cameroon and federal Republic again and this anglophone crisis would have been avoided.

His other regret was the similar position that the Cameroon Renaissance Movement or CRM adopted by also boycotting the legislative elections. He told me: I don't understand why these intellectuals are so confused. Prof Maurice Kamato criticized me violently in 1992 because I refused to take part in the legislative elections. It is even one of the reasons he left me to join Paul Biya. But, look, he is making the same mistake I did in 1992.

Legacy

John Fru Ndi may have left us, but his legacy remains and one of his greatest

legacy is the Social Democratic Front. She may have lost its lustre of the past, she nonetheless remains one of the best organized political party in Cameroon with a national presence. Its current chairman, Joshua Osih, has what it takes to revive the SDF because, he was a loyal servant of John Fru Ndi and more, he is courageous, tactical and intelligent. Once again, A Dieu chairman. We still love you and we will never forget you.

SDF SOUTH WEST REGIONAL EXECUTIVE MEETING: A CALL TO ACTION FOR CHANGE

Tiko subdivision, Cameroon: The Social Democratic Front (SDF) held its South West Regional Executive Meeting at Emergence Resort on the 15th of June 2024. The gathering brought together regional executives, including members of the National Executive Committee (NEC), with Regional Chairman Chief John Kona Makia presiding over the discussions.

The meeting focused on the health of the party in the region, a topic lauded as "positive" by the participants. The

deliberations centered around the implementation of past resolutions, particularly concerning:

* Corruption at Identification Centers: The meeting addressed the issue of corruption at identification centers, a significant concern for many Cameroonians seeking vital documents.

The participants left energized and determined to implement the outlined strategies, spreading the message of change deep into the South West.

The SDF, according to the meeting participants, is "breathing well" and stands ready to assume power, working in the interests of the people. Preparations for the upcoming political battles have begun, with the party actively mobilizing to achieve its objectives.
